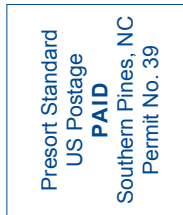

# Seminar Description

We will focus and review the trajectory of function and walking recovery post stroke and identify modifiable risk factors for declines for walking recovery. The presentation will recommend methods for improving walking recovery programs in community based rehabilitation. We will also review and recommend methods for standardized assessment of outcomes for stroke walking recovery programs. Finally we will discuss the challenges and barriers to implementing best practice models for walking recovery into routine practice and recommend “barrier busters”.

## Objectives

Upon completion, the learner will:

1. Identify risk factors for declines for walking recovery
2. Improve walking recovery in community based rehabilitation
3. Assess outcomes for stroke and spinal cord walking recovery programs
4. Implementation of best practice models for walking recovery

is professor in the Division of Physical Therapy at Duke University. Pam is a graduate of Columbia University and a nationally and internationally renowned physical therapist and epidemiologist, who is considered one of the world’s leading experts and consultants in the development of interventions for stroke and the selection of outcome measures for stroke recovery. A recognized leader and innovator in stroke rehabilitation; she has dedicated her career to elevating the science of rehabilitation, improving the physical function of the elderly, and improving stroke care and outcomes. She is a principal investigator of an NIH funded trial in walking recovery. Most importantly her passion is to contribute to the implementation of evidence based practice models into routine clinical care.
